**What is Low Impact Development?** LID is a sustainable landscaping approach that can be used to replicate or restore natural hydrological processes. Examples of LID practices include rain gardens, rain barrels, permeable pavement, green roofs, and bioswales. LID techniques help to reduce the volume of stormwater runoff and hence improve the water quality of our local waterways.
