What do I need for an NMP Update Working Session?



Your NMP binder from your original NMP class, and your most recently updated NMP (if you have one). This is the binder with all of your maps, soil information, etc.



Your login/password information for goCrop.



New manure test(s) (required every year) and soil tests (required every 3 years), if you have them.



Farm records for 2019: manure spreading records, crop records, grazing records, animal numbers, etc.



Reporting forms for CSFO/MFO/LFO or any other certification.



Payment (via debit/credit card) if your goCrop subscription is not up-to-date.
