### **Stormwater Reduction in the Town of Brandon**

Through a bidding process the Rutland Natural Resources Conservation District (RNRCD) hired Watershed Consulting Associates, LLC to complete 100% level plans with construction details, bid documents for construction contractor and operation & maintenance plan for two stormwater BMP retrofits identified in the Town of Brandon Stormwater Master Plan Final Plan dated October 31, 2017 by Watershed Consulting Associates, LLC.

#1. Pearl Street – Bio-Swales

#2. Café Provence – Concrete dry well and a lined bioretention practice.

The focus will be on improving water quality by reducing and treating stormwater runoff in the Neshobe watershed in the Town of Brandon. Plans for construction is Spring – Summer 2021.

The proposed project is a collaboration among RNRCD, LCBP and the Town of Brandon. This project has been funded by an agreement awarded by the Great Lakes Fishery Commission (GLFC) to the NEIWPC in partnership with the Lake Champlain Basin Program (LCBP).
