
WHAT IS A LWAP?

Tool - Assessment and planning tool that identifies the greatest threats (stressors & conditions)* to the lake ecosystem.

*including stormwater runoff, sedimentation & nutrients, erosion, invasive species, habitat loss

Process - 2-year process of field assessments of shorelines, roadways & streams, *community input and prioritization*

Report – LWAP Final Report is a guide for community planning and project development.



Outcomes & Deliverables:

- Digital library, maps of sediment & phosphorus sources
- Core Assessment Areas
- I0 Lake Wise assessments
- Up to 35 project summaries
- Five 30% designs
- Final Report

WORK PLAN & TIMELINE

January 2022 – Desktop review of the watershed conditions and resources.

March 2022 - Kick-off Meeting

Sept 2022 - Approved Quality Assurance Plan

Fall 2022 – Fall 2023 Field Assessments

August 2023 – Public Meeting Present priority areas & recommendations; Gather community input

November 2023 Plan completed & presented to stakeholders.

-Work with landowners and partners to complete (5) 30% designs on priority projects.


2. Final LWAP Plan completed & presented to stakeholders in November.
